8.0 The Interjection:

Definition: An Interjection is a word which expresses some sudden feeling or emotion.

It will be noticed that they are not grammatically related to the other words in a sentence.

8.1 Individual Words:

1. Individual words **Hellow! Alas! Hurray! Ah!** etc. are called Interjections.

Examples: 1. Hello! What are you doing there?

2. Alas! He is dead.

3. Hurrah! We have won the game.

4. Ah! Have they gone?

5. Oh! I got such a fright.

6. Hush! Don't make a noise.

2. Interjections may express **Joy**.

Examples: 1. Hurrah! 2. huzza!

3. Interjections may express **Grief**.

Example: 1. alas!

4. Interjections may express **Surprise**.

Examples: 1. ha! 2. what!

5. Interjections may express **Approval**.

Example: 1. bravo!
