8.0 <u>The Interjection:</u>
<u>Definition:</u> An Interjection is a word which expresses some sudden feeling or emotion.
It will be noticed that they are not grammatically related to the other words in a sentence.
8.1 <u>Individual Words:</u>
1. Individual words Hellow! Alas! Hurray! Ah! etc. are called Interjections.
Examples: 1. Hello! What are you doing there?
2. Alas! He is dead.
3. Hurrah! We have won the game.
4. Ah! Have they gone?
5. Oh! I got such a fright.
6. Hush! Don't make a noice.
2. Interjections may express <u>Joy</u> .
Examples: 1. Hurrah! 2. huzza!
3. Interjections may express <u>Grief</u> .
Example: 1. alas!
4. Interjections may express <u>Surprise</u> .
Examples: 1. ha! 2. what!
5. Interjections may express Approval.
Example: 1. bravo!
